In 1996, in response to the prevalence of family violence in the area, Chief Judge Robert L. Carter, Judge Cynthia M. Raccuglia, and Judge William R. Banich, along with other local judges, convened the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit Family Violence Prevention Council. Since that time, hundreds of community leaders and other volunteers have worked together to address how we can end family violence in our communities.

In 2002, the Grundy County Committee was formed. One task given to the Grundy County Committee was to review a resource manual that the Council had previously developed. The purpose of the resource manual is to provide referral information to victims of family violence. To this end, the Grundy County Committee of the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit Family Violence Prevention Council presents this Resource Manual.
