Banich, along with other local judges, convened the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit Family Violence Prevention Council. Since that time, hundreds of community leaders and other volunteers have worked together to address how we can end family violence in our communities.

In 2002 the Grundy County Committee was formed and the first Resource Manual was revised. Since the purpose of the Manual is to provide up-to-date referral information to victims of family violence, the Committee has once again taken on the task of updating the Resource Manual in 2009.

We hope that you find the Resource Manual to be informative and useful in your practice. By including information in this Resource Manual, we are in no way making a recommendation for that agency, nor does the exclusion of any agency mean that its services are not recommended.
